Training

- We completed our annual service test on all the department's fire hose.

- Driver Operator – We continue to work on our apparatus taskbook. Aerial stabilization drill, relay pumping, and EVOC course were some of the drills the shifts worked on.
- Pub-Ed – Firefighter for the day was held for two days in May. We had a total of 4 area students participate in firefighter activities. The students' parents also were able to observe in the activities.
