1. 2022 Millage Rate Public Hearing

Mr. Trocquet presented the item and stated that each year in August, the Town calculates its share of property taxes which are used for General Fund expenditures that year. The public hearing was to review the proposed millage rate.

He added that the proposed 2.889 millage rate was estimated to provide revenue for approximately 15% of the budgeted General Fund expenses for the 2022/2023 fiscal year. He shared that staff recommended the Town maintain the 2.3889 millage rate for the 15th year in a row. He stated that property values had increased reflecting an advertisement for a tax increase, although the millage rate had stayed the same. He directed Council to page six which detailed the current property tax digest and the 5-year history table of the levy.
