1. A Public Hearing for the Revised Proposed 2025 Millage Rate to Remain at 2.889. -
Brandon Perkins, Town Manager

Mr. Perkins explained that House Bill 581 was passed by legislation last year and the citizens voted on a constitution update last November. This caps property assessments at 3% or the rate of inflation. It was beneficial to homeowners; however, it affects the cities.

He shared the slides from the initial millage rate public hearings that took place in October. He stated that due to a miniscule mis figuring of a difference of approximately \$1,200 from the tax office, the public hearings needed to be heard once more. He added that the figures would be corrected in the slides and placed on the Town's website for viewing.
