AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE TOWN OF TYRONE; TO PROVIDE FOR ACKNOWLEDGMENT AND APPROVAL OF THE EMPLOYEE HANDBOOK; TO PROMOTE THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY, AND WELFARE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL FOR THE TOWN OF TYRONE THAT DIVISION 1 OF ARTICLE III OF CHAPTER 2 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE TOWN OF TYRONE BE AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. By deleting Section 2-138 Employee Handbook of Division 1 Generally of Article III Officers and Employees of Chapter 2 Administration in its entirety, and by enacting, in lieu thereof, a new Section 2-138 Employee Handbook of Division 1 Generally of Article III Officers and Employees of Chapter 2 Administration to read as follows:

Sec. 2-138. Employee Handbook.

The Mayor and Council hereby approve and adopt the Employee Handbook for the Town of Tyrone which is on file with the Town Clerk. The Mayor and Council may, from time to time, provide revisions to the Employee Handbook. Any revisions to the Employee Handbook made by the Mayor and Council shall

update the Employee Handbook, then on file with the Town Clerk.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by the Mayor and Council for the Town of Tyrone.

Section 3. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4. In any event any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall be declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall in no manner affect other sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases of this Ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect as if the section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not a part thereof. The Mayor and Council hereby declares that it would have passed the remaining parts of this Ordinance if it had known that such part or parts hereof would be declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.
