Celebrating the 250th Anniversary of the United States of America

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED, that the **Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Tyrone, Georgia**, do hereby proclaim the year **2026** as a time to commemorate the **250th Anniversary of the United States of America**, and encourage all residents to observe this milestone through patriotic observances, educational programs, and community events that honor our nation's history and inspire future generations.
