As a reminder, your taxing unit participates in selecting members of the Waller County Appraisal District's board of directors. You were notified back on June 16<sup>th</sup>, 2025, of your vote entitlement. The board is composed of five members who serve two-year terms, all of which expire December 31, 2025.

The election calendar for the 2026 – 2027 Board of Directors election is as follows:

The presiding officer of the governing body of the unit shall submit the names of the unit's nominees to the chief appraiser **before** October 15<sup>th</sup>. To nominate, the governing body must adopt a resolution nominating the candidate by formal action. The officer must provide a certified copy of the resolution and may include a cover letter naming the nominee.

On October 15<sup>th</sup>, the chief appraiser will prepare a ballot listing the nominees in alphabetical order. The chief appraiser will deliver a copy of the ballot to the presiding officer of each voting entity.

No later than December 15<sup>th</sup>, each entity must cast its vote for one or more nominees, formally adopt a resolution naming the person or persons for whom it votes and submit a certified copy to the chief appraiser. Ballots received by the chief appraiser after December 15<sup>th</sup>, may not be counted.

The chief appraiser will count the votes, declare the results, and notify the winner, the nominees, and the presiding officers of each taxing entity. A tie vote will be resolved by a method of chance chosen by the chief appraiser.
