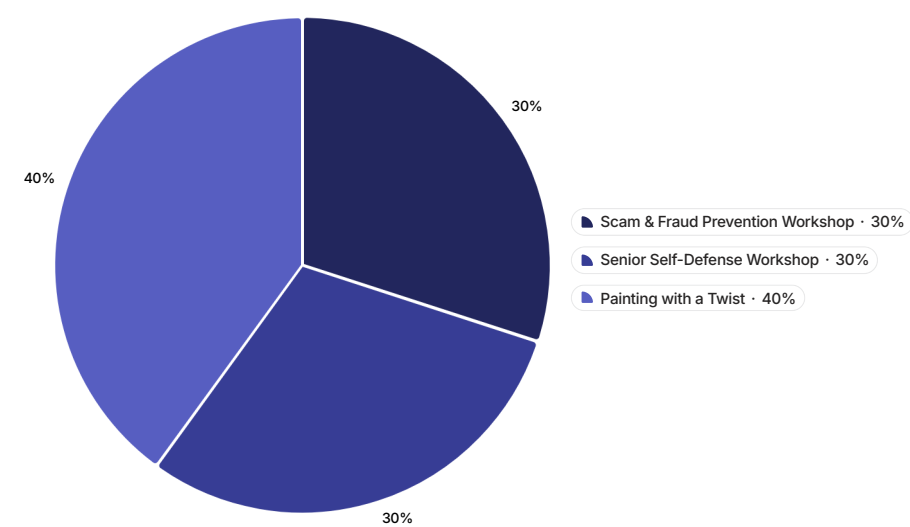
Support three educational and wellness events for 20–30 senior citizens in the City of Prairie View.

The requested \$500 will support three separate community events designed to educate, empower, and engage approximately 20–30 senior citizens in the City of Prairie View.

Event 1 – Scam & Fraud Prevention Workshop (\$150) Funds will provide educational materials, participant handouts, and light refreshments to help seniors recognize and avoid financial scams, identity theft, and elder fraud.	Event 2 – Senior Self-Defense Workshop (\$150) Funds will support participant materials, basic training supplies, instructor support, and refreshments while teaching practical personal safety and situational awareness techniques.	Event 3 – Painting with a Twist (\$200) Funds will purchase canvases, paint, brushes, aprons, and other art supplies, along with light refreshments, to promote creativity, social engagement, and mental wellness.
