Urban Twinwood, LP subdivided the property that is subject to the Agreement, and identified in Section 1 of the Agreement as WCAD property ID number 268426. After the subdivision, the property subject to the Agreement was assigned WCAD property ID number 270530, and is also identified by situs address 2434 Discovery Hills Pkwy, Brookshire, Texas 77423. Twinwood Gravity Operating, LLC acquired the property from Urban Twinwood, LP, and is the current owner of the property.
