The first inside gas leak 911 call was dispacted at 1155 and was determined to be an issue with the natural gas service on the HVAC units. As of 1255 the Town of Warrenton atmosphere, businesses, and residences where overcome with a heavy gas odor, and multiple 911 calls											
received from all over the Town of Warrenton area. This Situation status represents the status of Warrenton lifelines as of March 5, 2025 at 1400. The Town EM J. Switzer called FQ County EM at 1315 to request assistance. The county EM was requested to respond to gas leak calls											
to other areas of town to establish what the cause of the sudden surge of inside gas leaks. The Town EM responded to 410 Rosedale Court, 77 Main Street, & 800 Waterloo Road. At 1326 Aaron Boeke, VP Gas Operations for Columbia Gas of VA was contacted and informed of											
a local natural gas emerency in Warrenton. At 1343 the Town EM contacted VDEM, Alexa Boggs, CRC to inform her of the issue and inform that the Town would be fully activating its EOC.
