Areas of Concern:

The first inside gas leak 911 call was dispatched at 1155 and was determined to be an issue with the natural gas service on the HVAC units. As of 1255 the Town of Warrenton atmosphere, businesses, and residences were overcome with a heavy gas odor and multiple 911 calls received from all over the Town of Warrenton area. This Situation status represents the status of Warrenton lifelines as of March 5, 2025 at 1500. The 911 calls since the initial call are 39 calls for service. The public safety system is overwhelmed and has requested mutual aid from all surrounding jurisdictions and has begun to establish an area command at the Warrenton Volunteer Fire Company. Town Office of Emergency Management has activated its EOC to full staffing. EOC team notification has been sent out. EOC at Town Hall, 21 Main Street, 3rd Floor.

At 1424 Petrina Jones Wroblewski, Columbia Gas of VA, Liaison Officer informed the Town EM that the Columbia Gas Mobile Command Center and Emergency Operations Team were enroute to Warrenton with an 1.5 hour ETA. Derek Powell, EOC Rep., Columbia Gas responded to the EOC and arrived at 1445.
