A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE REDUCTION OF THE MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT IN SCHOOL ZONES DURING THE MORNING DROP OFF AND AFTERNOON PICK UP PERIODS

WHEREAS, § 46.2-873(H) of the Code of Virginia permits the Town of Warrenton to pass an ordinance and establish a School Speed Zone and install flashing warning signs at Warrenton Middle School (Waterloo St.) that would reduce speeds to fifteen (15) mph during morning drop off and afternoon pick up periods upon receipt of a resolution by the School Board requesting such reduction in speed limits.

WHEREAS, it is the prerogative of the Fauquier County School Board to support the establishment of a School Speed Zone and installation of warning signs at Warrenton Middle School,

WHEREAS, the Fauquier County School Board finds that such a reduction in maximum speeds would promote the safety of the school children attending Warrenton Middle School,

RESOLVED, the Fauquier County School Board supports the reduction of maximum speed during morning drop off and afternoon pick up from twenty-five (25) miles per hour to fifteen (15) miles per hour in the above listed school zone,

RESOLVED FURTHER by the Fauquier County School Board this 12th day of September 2022, that the School Board requests the Town of Warrenton to establish a School Speed Zone ordinance setting a maximum speed of fifteen (15) miles per hour during morning drop off and afternoon pick up periods in the Warrenton Middle School zone on Waterloo St.
