RESOLUTION APPROVING APPLICATIONS AND DEVELOPMENT PLANS FOR CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS AT FAUQUIER HIGH SCHOOL

- WHEREAS, the School Board of Fauquier County, Virginia (the "Board") owns contiguous parcels of property in the Town of Warrenton, Virginia (the "Town") identified as Parcel Identification Numbers 6974-86-3278-000, 6974-75-6925-000, 6974-75-6703-000, and 6974-76-0449-000 (collectively referred to as the "Property"); and
- WHEREAS, the Property houses Fauquier High School and related improvements and uses, including areas dedicated to agricultural education; and
- WHEREAS, the Agriculture Department of Fauquier High School proposes to expand its programs, which will require certain improvement to the Property as identified in the materials provided to the Board for its October 17, 2022 meeting (the 'Plan'); and
- WHEREAS, the Town requires the Board, as the owner of the Property, to approve the Plan and authorize the application for and issuance of permits related to the Plan; and
- WHEREAS, on September 28, 2022, the Board's Building Committee unanimously approved the Plan; and
- WHEREAS, the Board believes the Plan is in the best interests of Fauquier County High School, its students, and the citizens of the Town of Warrenton and Fauquier County.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of Fauquier County, Virginia that the Plan is approved and the Superintendent, or their designee, is authorized to execute any applications, permits, or other documents necessary to effectuate the Plan and any improvements or land disturbance related thereto.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board approves and authorizes the Superintendent, or their designee, to apply for a written permit from the Warrenton Town Council as required by Section 3-5 of the Warrenton Town Code for the keeping of swine in accordance with the Plan, and supports the issuance of such permit by the Town Council.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board, as a governmental partner of the Town, requests that the Town and Town Council waive any fees associated with applications, permits, and approvals related to the Plan.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no appropriations are made herein and the expenditure of public funds for the Plan shall be consistent with appropriating actions of the Board.
