

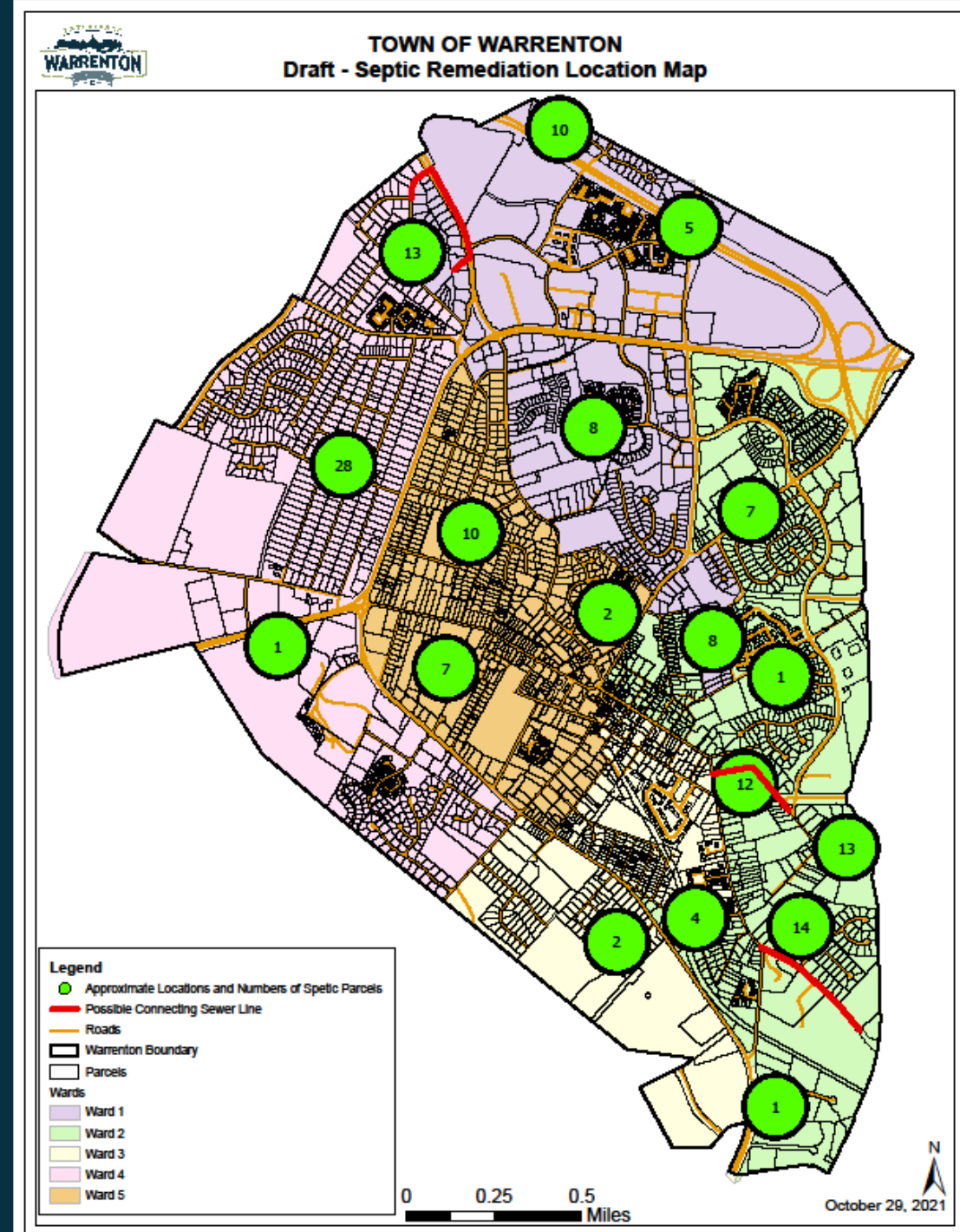

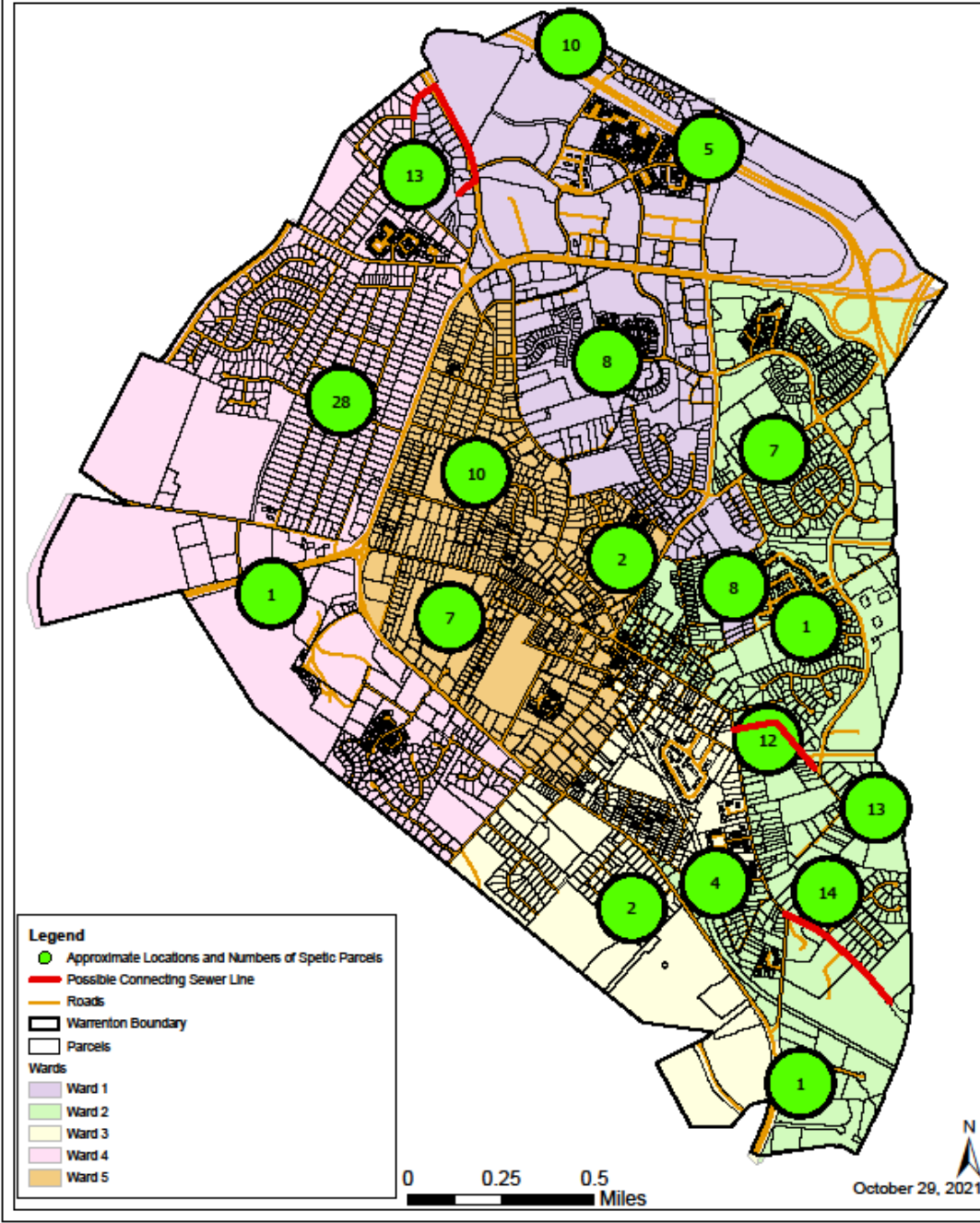
# Committee

- Established by Town Council July, 2021
- Data and Analysis
- Cross referenced multiple data sources (E911, billing, Department of Health Permits)
- GIS Layer and Mapping
- Public Workshop
- Surveys of properties 2022
- Applied for State ARPA Grants 2022
- 2023 Potential One Grant/Denied One Grant



# What the Data Reveals

- Parcels on septic exist across all wards
- Septic locations, conditions, and age vary across income levels
- There are possible gaps in the data
  - For example, homes built before 1950 may precede VDH permitting

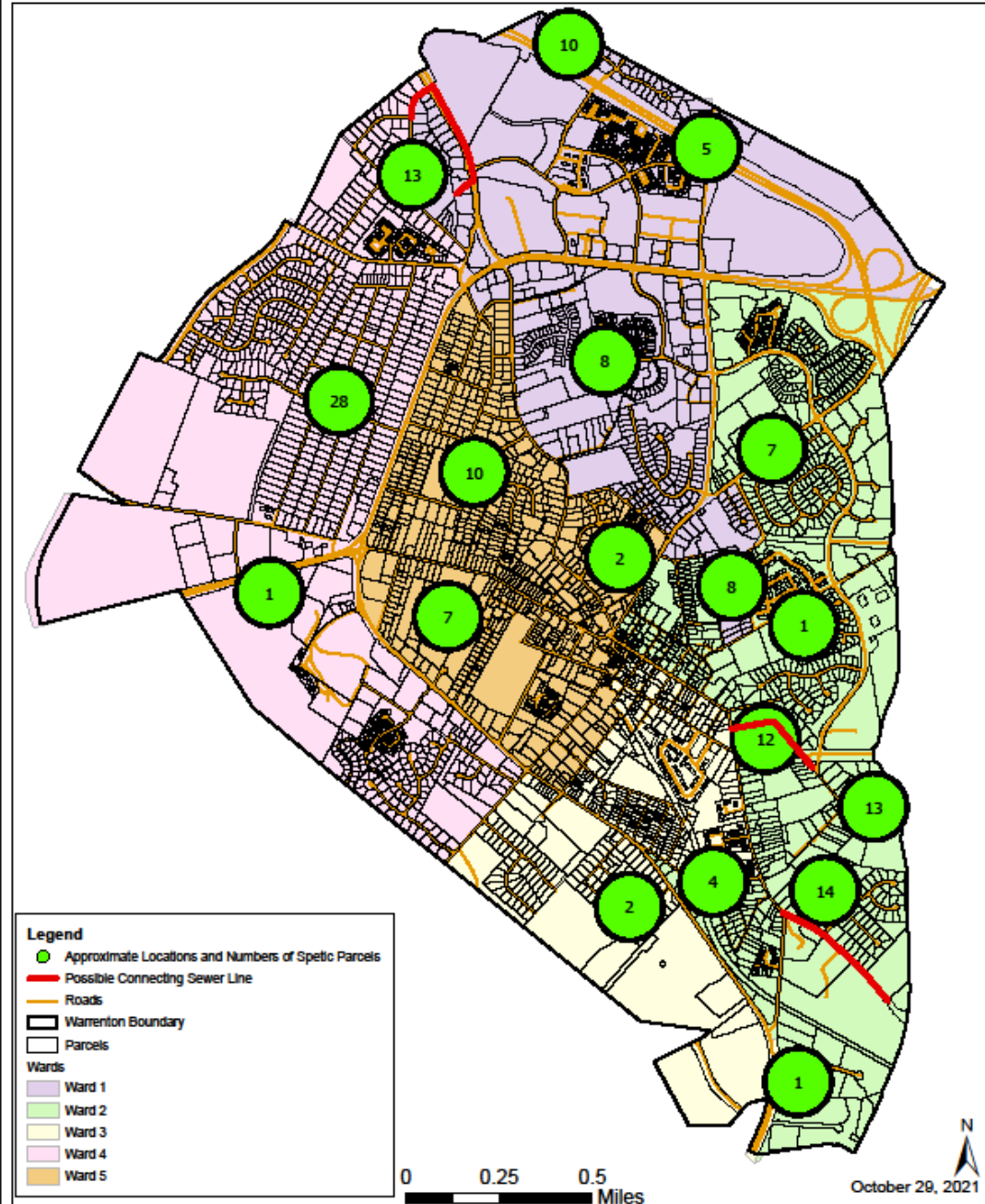


# ARPA Funding

- \$750,000 Septic Local Partner Program
- **First Come, First Serve**
- \$152,100 Income Limit
- 100%/50% Cost Share
- \$40,000/\$20,000 per parcel
- \$10,800 Sewer Fee
- Reimbursement Grant
- 35% Administration
- Can not be used for sewer lines
- Approximately 84 parcels
- $12 = 750,000 \times .65 / 40,000$
