Please accept this as the quarterly report for the **Public Works & Utilities** departments.

Commendable Achievements:

- An employee from the Utilities Department attended AWWA (American Water Works Association) training in Richmond.
- We sponsored the Annual Touch A Truck Event again this year on May 3rd. With approximately 861 attendees, and some schools making this their field trip, it was a great success again. Thanks to all the Departments that contributed to making this the largest one yet.



• Congratulations to the recipients of the Richard R. Wines awards this year, James Pyne from the Utilities Department and Roger Heflin from Public Works. James I. Pyne retired from our employment at the end of June. This was after almost 20 years of dedicated service to the Town.





Public Works:

• The crew assisted the Master Gardeners in planting a tree for Earth Day.





• John Paul Design Build donated 3 Dogwood trees to the Warrenton Cemetery. They were installed by Town Crew.





• Town crew widened the road through the cemetery.





• Crew Installed concrete curb and bioswale to improve the stormwater drainage on Gaines Street.





 Crew removed the undergrowth from the swings in the Rady Park Playground and then installed mulch.





• Town crew repurposed some of the old road millings and installed it in the landscaping shed at the rear of the Public Works Facility.





• The crew removed the overgrowth of bamboo at Ivy Hill.

Walkability Study Repairs included:

- Our contractor, Espina Contracting has continued to repair/replace 17 ADA ramps on Oak Springs Dr.
- On West Lee Highway by Blalock Cycles, we contracted a contractor to install a pedestrian guardrail along the newly installed concrete sidewalk. This completes walking accessibility from Winchester Street to Blackwell Rd.





Public Utilities:

- Staff completed the scheduled Spring fire hydrant flushing routine for the year.
- Staff measured and are raising the manhole lids in various locations in the Town. This is for the upcoming paving projects.
- The crew hydro-excavated around the foundation at Town Hall at 21 Main Street.
- Hydro-Excavated the water-line on Gold Cup Drive to determin the size of it. This was for the betterment project.
- The crew has started upgrading from the old style meter setters to the newer style on Cherry Tree Land. Approximately 15 have been completed to date.
- 13 Responding to customer complaints/issues.
- 1 Sanitary sewer laterals was repaired.




