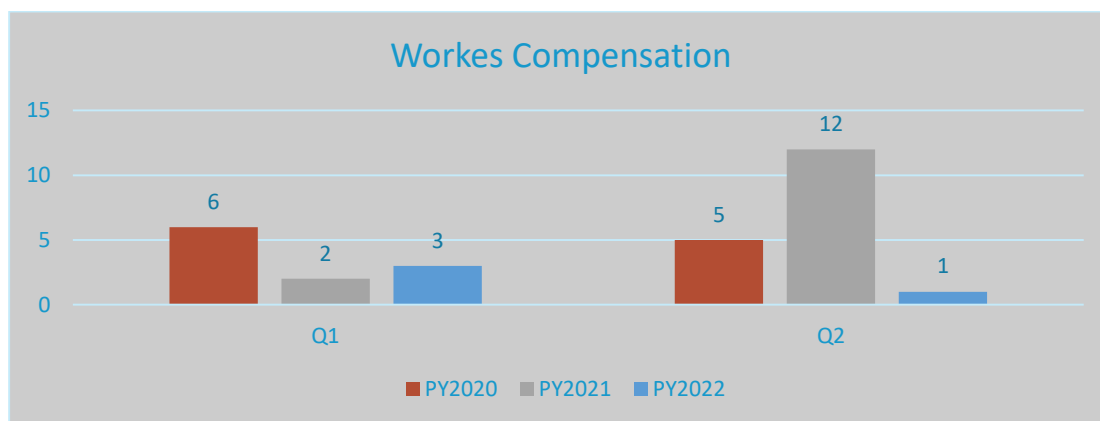
SUMMARY

OEM is responsible for all aspects of the Town's comprehensive emergency preparedness program and workplace safety. Since its inception, OEM has collaborated with internal and external partners to reimagine current practices and drive innovation to mitigate risk.

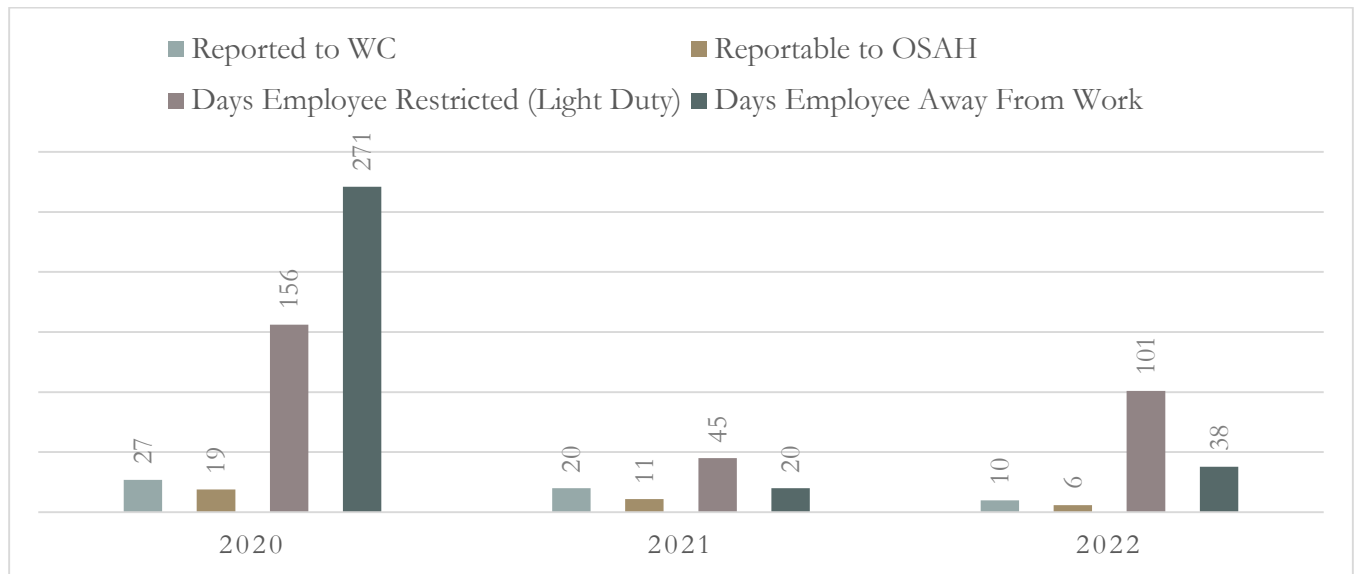
Workplace Injuries and Illness

The below charts represent workers compensation claims for the associated policy years. The policy year runs from July 1 through June 30, and the related year is when the policy took effect (i.e., policy year PY22=FY23). *It is important to note that the numbers represented below are all incidents reported to workers' compensation, not just OSHA-reportable injuries or illnesses.*



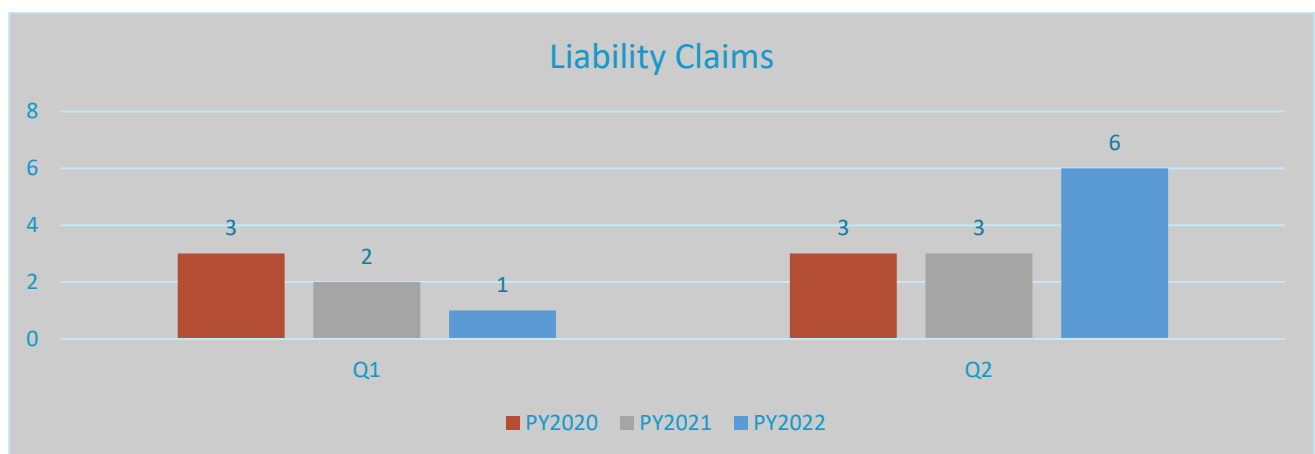
OSHA

OSHA recordable injuries and illnesses are tracked during the calendar year and are reported to OSHA in January. The below chart represents the calendar year breakdown of total incidents reported to workers compensation and actual OSHA reportable injuries or illnesses.
