Review and take possible action: Amend Chapter 500-7, Temporary Restricted Parking

BACKGROUND:

The City can claim phosphorus reduction credit through its leaf collection program under the Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) Permit. The City is required to have parking removal provisions in ordinance in order to claim the reduction credit. The Engineering Division is looking to modify Chapter 500-7(C) to plainly list municipal leaf collection activities as a purpose for temporary restricted parking.
