So far in 2026, excluding July 3-5, we have taken 11 fireworks complaints. Of those, 8 were UTL (unable to locate) and 3 were verbal warnings.

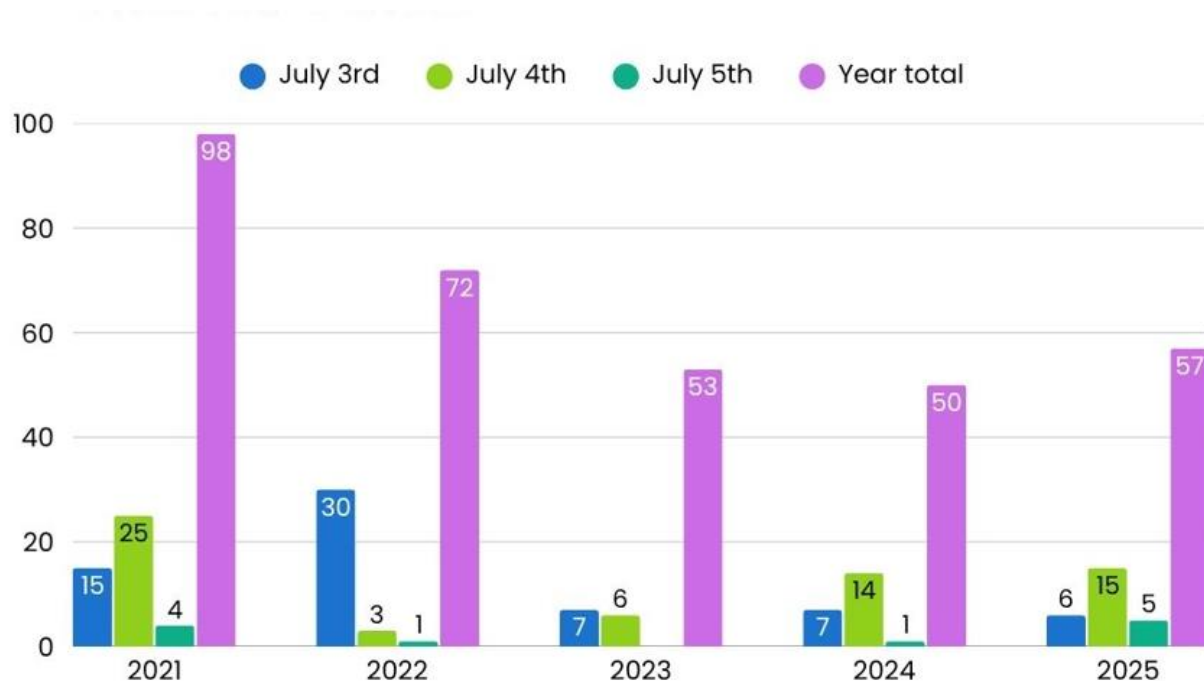
On July 3, 2026 we took 5 complaints. Of those, 4 were UTL and one was a verbal warning.

On July 4, 2026 we took 15 complaints. Of those, 14 were UTL and one was a verbal warning.

On July 5, 2026 we took 8 complaints. Of those, 7 were UTL and one was a verbal warning.
