Review and take possible action: An Ordinance to repeal a portion of Section 500-6 Parking limitations. A. (2) No parking in loading zones

The property owner of 217 N. Fifth Street has requested that the loading zone located on Jones Street near N. Fifth Street, and adjacent to her property, be removed to allow for conventional street parking. The loading zone was created by the Public Safety & Welfare Committee in 2014 at the request of the former property owner/business, The Kid's Palace, which no longer operates from 217 N.
