Dear Ms. Patzer:

The City of Watertown retains broad discretionary authority in denying, recommending denial, or granting or recommending granting of license applications based on the City of Watertown's Licensing Guidelines as adopted by the Licensing Board. The City's Police Department used these guidelines when reviewing your application to make recommendation that you should not be issued a Beverage Operator License based on the following:

CATEGORY V. (Applicants who have pending matter for any related charge as of the date of application, are not eligible for a license or a renewal of a license, if a conviction of the offense would place the applicant in any other category. The applicant may re-apply when the underlying matter is concluded.)

Your license application may be discussed in a closed session part of the meeting during which you will have an opportunity to state the reason you feel your application should be approved. The licensing board will then return to open session and take a vote. After the Licensing Board has made their decision, it will then be brought to the City Council for their approval or denial at the following regularly scheduled City Council meeting (3rd Tuesday of the month, 7pm, Watertown City Hall Council Chambers).
