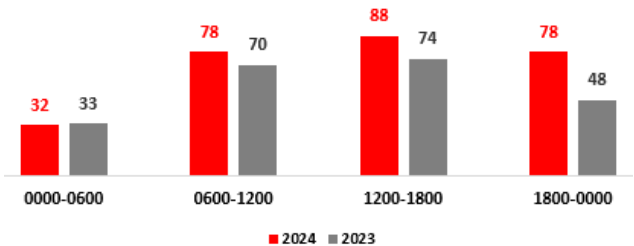

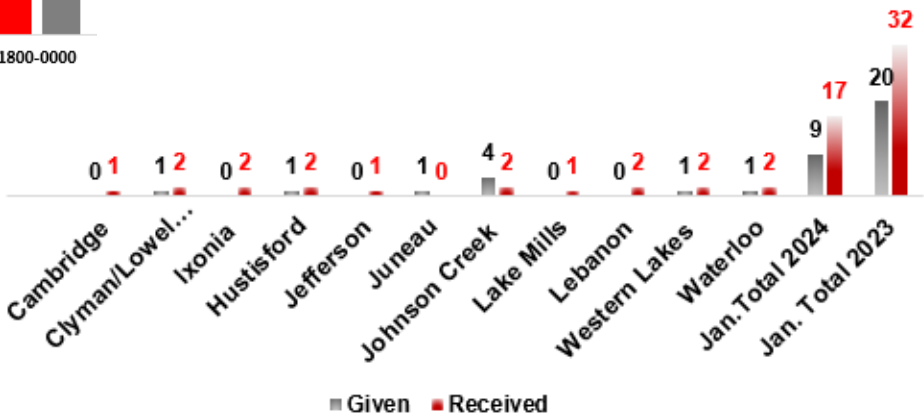
## 3-year Comparison of Calls

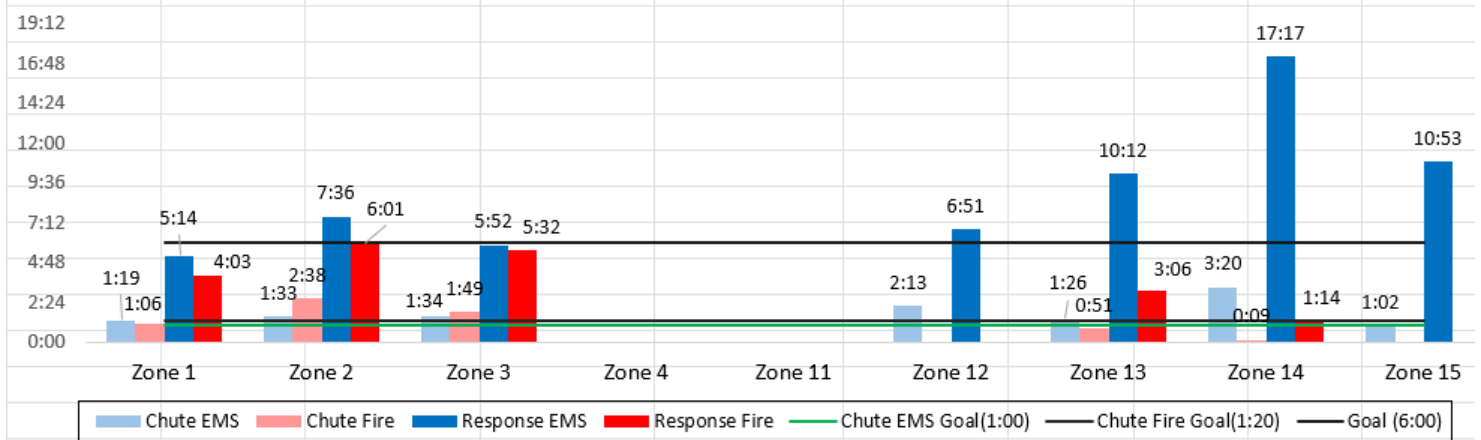

## Simultaneous Calls Breakdown

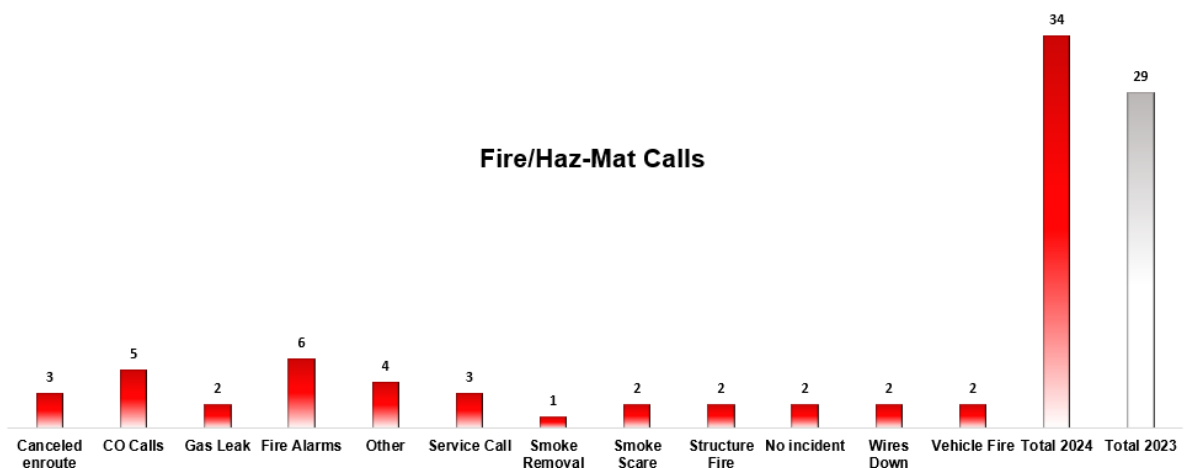

## Chute/Response Times By Zone



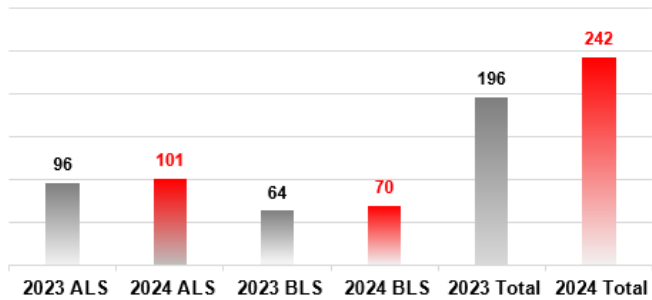

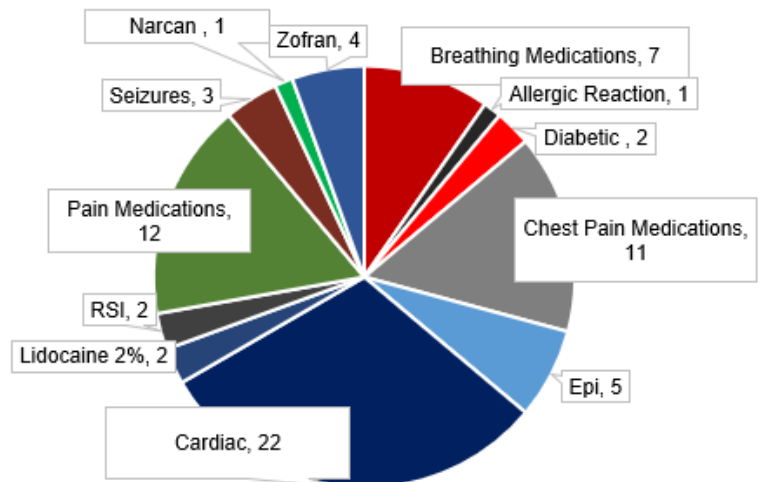
## Patient Contact by Age



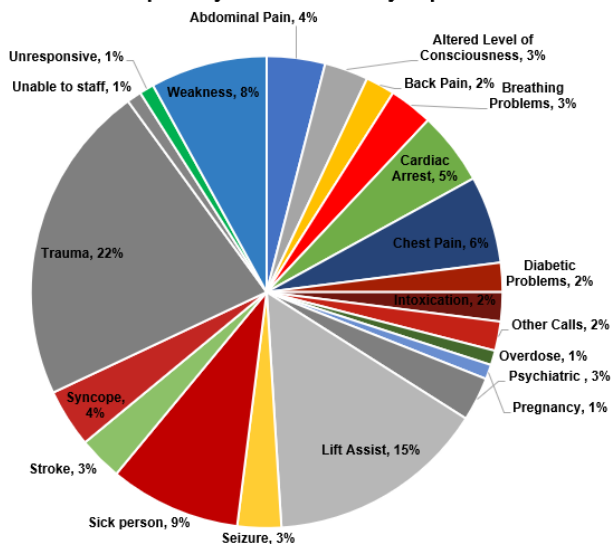

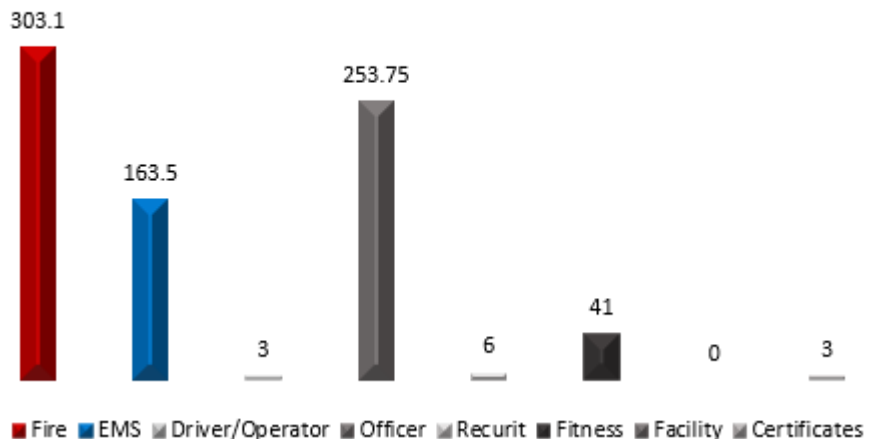
January 10th, WFD officers and future officers attended an Officer development class on leadership by Conway.

# Incidents



## January 7th- Structure Fire

1013 S. 3rd St., Watertown

Engine 4161& 4162, 4110, and 4153 responded to a structure fire. Mutual Aid was requested. The fire in the chimney that spread to the roof was knocked down. Total on scene time was 2 1/2 hours.

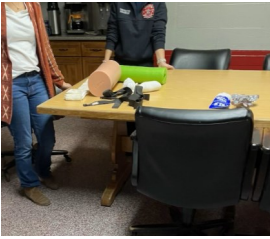


## January 18th- Structure Fire

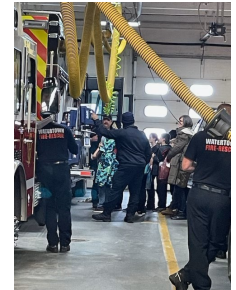
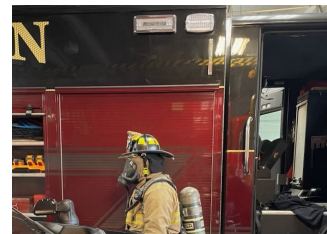
## **January 10th- Watertown Leadership Class** Watertown Fire Department
