






#### 3-year Comparison of Calls





#### Number of Calls Between the Hours of:











#### **Emergency Medical** Advanced/Basic Life Saving Calls




# Patient Contact by Age 34 30 18 12


#### **Overdoses**




#### Medications Administered




January 10th, WFD officers and future officers attended an Officer development class on leadership by Conway.

## Incidents



#### January 7th-Structure Fire

1013 S. 3rd St., Watertown

Engine 4161& 4162, 4110, and 4153 responded to a structure fire. Mutual Aid was requested. The fire in the chimney that spread to the roof was knocked down. Total on scene time was 2 1/2 hours.



## January 18th- Structure Fire 1216 Utah St., Watertown

Engine 4161& 4162, 4110, 4102, and 4153 responded to a dryer fire at a laundromat. The fire was extinguished with a fire extinguisher prior to arrival, however the clothes in the dryer were still on fire and taken outside and extinguished with a water can. The building was ventilated. Total on scene time was 45 min.

#### January 24th- Motor Vehicle Crash Exit 267.8 WB 194

Engine 4161responded to a mutual aid request for a crash on the interstate. WFD assisted with patient extrication, movement, and care. Total on scene time was 1 hour.

# January 26th- Structure Fire 211 N Maple St., Watertown

Engine 4161, 4102, and 4153 responded to a structure fire. On arrival flames were seen on the detached garage. Mutual aid was requested. The fire was extinguished and overhaul done. Total on scene time was 1 3/4 hours.
