Review and take possible action: Hire Visu-Sewer to perform storm sewer rehabilitation work for \$126,000

Background

City-owned storm sewer beneath S. Church Street near 1530 Utah Street and the parking lot at 1520 S. Church Street (Aldi's) is in need of repair. The 84" corrugated metal pipe (CMP) serves a large drainage area and needs to be sealed to ensure that it continues to function.

The City's Engineering Division sought a quote from Visu-Sewer to seal the pipe. After reviewing repair options, the most cost-effective scope of work entails cementitious lining of the pipe between the 3 o'clock and 9 o'clock positions. The cost to complete this work is \$126,000 and falls within the approved budgeted amount for this project. A draft resolution is attached for review. Funding would come from the Storm Water Utility Capital Outlay Account.
