

**Common Council Minutes  
Tuesday June 16, 2026**

**CALL TO ORDER**

Mayor Stocks called the regular meeting of the City of Watertown Common Council to order at 7:06 p.m. on Tuesday, June 16, 2026. This meeting was open for attendance in the council chambers as well as virtually.

**ROLL CALL**

Roll call indicated the following Alderpersons present: Ald. Lampe, Berg, Nitecki, Blanke, Smith, Arnett, Haase, and Moldenhauer. Absent was Ald. Davis. City staff present were Fire Chief Tanya Reynen, Police Captain John Cacuat, City Attorney Ali Panagopoulos, Finance Director Mark Stevens, Streets Superintendent Stacy Winkelman, Public Works Director Andrew Beyer (virtual), and City Clerk Megan Dunneisen.

**MINUTES OF PRECEDING MEETING**

Mayor Stocks inquired if there were additions or corrections to minutes of the Common Council meeting held Tuesday, June 2, 2026. There being none, Ald. Smith moved to approve, seconded by Ald. Berg and carried by unanimous voice vote.

Karah Pugh of N8535 Hustiford Rd spoke in favor of the Temporary Designated Outdoor Refreshment Area (TDORA).

Ald. Blanke made a motion to move Resolution 9876 to immediately following Committee Appointments, seconded by Ald. Berg and carried by unanimous voice vote.

Wellmann), seconded by Ald. Lampe and carried by roll call vote: Yes-8; No-0; Abstain-0.

Ald. Moldenhauer made a motion to reconvene into open session, seconded by Ald. Nitecki and carried by roll call vote: Yes-8; No-0; Abstain-0.

Ald. Arnett made a motion to approve the claim for damages of J. Wellmann, seconded by Ald. Blanke and carried by roll call vote: Yes-7; No-0; Abstain-1 (Lampe).

Ald. Blanke made a motion to approve the application for a change of agent from Joery's Inc d/b/a Lindberg's By The River located at 1413 Oconomowoc Ave from the late Josephine Lindberg to David Saxby for licensing year ending June 30, 2026 conditioned upon verification that the corporation remains properly structured and that the applicants have the legal authority to operate the business on behalf of the corporation, seconded by Ald. Haase and carried by unanimous voice vote.

Ald. Lampe made a motion to approve the application for a "Class B" Malt and Liquor license from Divots LLC d/b/a Divots Golf Bar (Richard Elertson, Agent) located at 644 S. Church Street for licensing year July 1, 2026 - June 30, 2027 conditioned upon successful completion of all required City inspections; and approval of the required Conditional Use Permit, seconded by Ald. Blanke and carried by unanimous voice vote.

The motion to approve the renewals of JP Watertown Bowl – Watertown Bowl 18 and Watertown Bowl North carried by unanimous voice vote, with Ald. Blanke abstaining.

Ald. Blanke made a motion to approve the renewals of "Class A" Combination Malt and Liquor Licenses, Class "B" Malt Licenses, and "Class B" Combination Malt and Liquor Licenses (Exhibit B) that have missing/outstanding licensing requirements for licensing year July 1, 2026 - June 30, 2027, seconded by Ald. Moldenhauer and carried by unanimous voice vote.

Ald. Blanke made a motion to approve the renewals of Secondhand Article/Jewelry Licenses (Exhibit C) for licensing year July 1, 2026 - June 30, 2027, seconded by Ald. Haase and carried by unanimous voice vote.
