

RESOLUTION 2026-14

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WAUCHULA, FLORIDA, SETTING THE PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE FOR THE TENTATIVE BUDGET FOR THE 2026-2027 TAXING YEAR PURSUANT TO SECTION 200.065, FLORIDA STATUTES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, sets out the method of fixing millage by the governing body of a taxing authority; and

WHEREAS, Section 200.065(2)(d), Florida Statutes, requires the City Commission (hereinafter the “Commission”) of the City of Wauchula, Florida, (hereinafter the “City”) to compute the millage rate to be levied in relation to the “rolled-back rate” computed pursuant to Section 200.065(1), Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the “rolled-back rate” for the City computed by the Hardee County Property Appraiser pursuant to Section 200.065(1), Florida Statutes is 5.8318 mills; and

WHEREAS, the Commission of the City must set the proposed millage rate to be used in computing the amount of ad valorem taxed to be raised to fund the tentative budget; and

WHEREAS, the Commission of the City published notice of and held a public hearing on Monday, July 13, 2026 at 6:00 p.m. on the proposed millage rate, and adopted said proposed millage rate of 5.8318, which is equal to the “rolled-back rate”.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WAUCHULA, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. Pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, the Commission of the City sets the proposed millage rate at 5.8318 for the purpose of adopting a tentative Budget for the City for the taxing year 2026-2027.

Section 2. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval by the Commission.
