Peace River Park is owned and maintained by the City of Wauchula. The park offers hiking trails, canoe/kayak launches, picnic pavilions and an observation tower all at no charge to the park patrons. The park hours are from 7 am until dusk. The following rules and regulations must be adhered to; any violations may result in being trespassed from the park.

- Alcoholic beverages, profanity and obscenity **WILL NOT** be permitted.
- Hunting in the park is not permitted.
- The use of motorized vehicles, including all-terrain vehicles, is not permitted.
- No ropes or wires shall be attached to trees or buildings.
- All trash must be placed in garbage cans or dumpsters provided.
- All picnic sites must be left clean upon departure.
- Fires are allowed within provided fire rings. Searching for fire wood that has fallen is acceptable. However, cutting wood is **NOT ALLOWED**.
- Children are the responsibility of the parent/guardian at all times.
- Pets are welcome, but must be on a leash at all times. **ALL PET WASTE MUST BE CLEANED UP BY THE PET OWNER.**
- No feeding of wildlife at any time.
