SUMMARY and/or JUSTIFICATION:		Consider approval of a Professional Services Agreement with Metz, Husband & Daughton, P.A. for State Governmental Affairs and Legislative Consulting Services. The City previously retained Metz, Husband & Daughton, P.A. to represent the City before the Florida Legislature and Executive Branch agencies. The prior agreement was effective January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025, and provided governmental affairs, legislative advocacy, appropriations assistance, and grant funding support on behalf of the City. Approval of a new agreement will ensure continuity of representation before the Florida Legislature and Executive Branch and allow the firm to continue advocating for the City's legislative priorities and funding requests.
