A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTLAKE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE A PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT, IN A FORM ACCEPTABLE TO THE CITY ATTORNEY, WITH THE 9/11 REMEMBRANCE AND FIRST RESPONDER GROUP AND THE TUNNEL TO TOWERS FOUNDATION RELATED TO THE CITY'S 3RD ANNUAL 5K RUN/WALK EVENT SCHEDULED FOR SEPTEMBER 12, 2026; PROVIDING DIRECTION REGARDING FUNDRAISING ACTIVITIES; PROVIDING FOR CITY COUNCIL APPROVAL OF ANY CITY EXPENDITURES; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the proposed resolution authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and execute a Partnership Agreement in a form acceptable to the City Attorney. Any expenditures, sponsorship commitments, matching contributions, or other financial obligations on behalf of the City shall require separate City Council approval.

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it to be in the best interests of the City to approve and authorize the City Manager to negotiate and execute a Partnership Agreement, in a form acceptable to the City Attorney, with the 9/11 Remembrance and First Responder Group and the Tunnel to Towers Foundation related to the City's 3rd Annual 5K Run/Walk Event scheduled for September 12, 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTLAKE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "WHEREAS" clause is hereby ratified and confirmed by the City Council and incorporated herein by this reference.

SECTION 2. The City Council of the City of Westlake, Florida, hereby approves and authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and execute a Partnership Agreement, in a form acceptable to the City Attorney, with the 9/11 Remembrance and First Responder Group and the Tunnel to Towers Foundation related to the City's 3rd Annual 5K Run/Walk Event scheduled for September 12, 2026. Any expenditures, sponsorship commitments, matching contributions, or other financial obligations on behalf of the City shall require separate City Council approval.

SECTION 3. CONFLICTS. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. If any clause, section, other part or application of this Resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions or applications of this Resolution.
