A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTLAKE, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE PIGGYBACKING OF CITY OF PLANTATION CONTRACT NO. 005-24 WITH REDSPEED FLORIDA, LLC FOR SCHOOL ZONE SPEED DETECTION SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, staff evaluated available procurement alternatives and determined that utilizing a piggyback procurement through the City of Plantation's competitively awarded contract with RedSpeed Florida, LLC represents the most efficient and cost-effective procurement method available to the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Westlake deems it to be in the best interests of the City to approve the piggybacking of City of Plantation Contract No. 005-24 with RedSpeed, Florida, LLC for School Zone Speed Detection Services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTLAKE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "WHEREAS" clause is hereby ratified and confirmed by the City Council and incorporated herein by this reference.

SECTION 2. In accepting the recommendation of City staff, the City Council of the City of Westlake, Florida, hereby approves the piggybacking of City of Plantation Contract No. 005-24 with RedSpeed, Florida, LLC for School Zone Speed Detection Services.

SECTION 3. The City Council hereby approves and authorizes the Mayor or Vice Mayor to execute and deliver an Agreement with RedSpeed Florida, LLC which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

SECTION 4. CONFLICTS. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. If any clause, section, other part or application of this Resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions or applications of this Resolution.

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SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
