RESOLUTION 2023-10

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF WESTLAKE, FLORIDA, SELECTING A MEMBER OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO SERVE IN THE POSITION OF VICE-MAYOR UNTIL APRIL 2, 2024, PURSUANT TO THE CITY'S CHARTER; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 8D of the City's charter, the City of Westlake hereby selects a member of the sitting City Council to serve as the Vice-Mayor; and

WHEREAS, the Vice-Mayor shall serve until April 2, 2024, in the position of vice-mayor in the absence of the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, on April 2, 2024, the City Council shall again select a member of the sitting city council to serve in the position of vice-mayor; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTLAKE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The City Council for the City of Westlake, selects _____, of seat ____ to serve as the Vice-Mayor for the City of Westlake.

SECTION 2. Councilmember _____, of seat _____, shall serve as Vice-Mayor until April 2, 2024.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

SECTION 4. CONFLICTS. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. If any clause, section, other part or application of this Resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions or applications of this Resolution.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
