Dear Mayor O'Connor and Council:

Hope you are all well. I write to you today to advise of my sincere interest in the vacancy for Westlake City Council Seat 2. I truly believe I am the most qualified candidate to fill the position and likely the only candidate with a very specific agenda, detailed below. My only focus is to be the strongest possible advocate for the residents of Westlake and help make this new city the best in Florida. Plus, I am the only Westlake resident to appear on a ballot garnering 101,000 votes last November 5th for Port of Palm Beach Commissioner Group 2 including winning in Westlake. All of the current Port Commissioners live along the coast, more than an hour from Westlake, and my primary goal in running was to give the residents of Westlake and the surrounding area sorely needed local representation on the Port Commission. The residents here know me and know what I stand for. My first priority is the immediate drive to establish a "Town Center" on the designated vacant parcel. The model for the project must be the "Alton Town Center" located on Donald Ross Road in Palm Beach Gardens, which was completed in 2022. Extremely well designed with shops, sit down restaurants, retail stores, banks, landscaping, etc. Making contact with the developer in accordance with all laws and statutes, is a logical first step. Westlake needs this project ASAP!

The Westlake City Charter was written before the City was incorporated without input from residents, since there were none at that time. It would greatly benefit the citizens of Westlake for the City Council to establish a Charter Review Committee now and bring its recommendations to the City Council for public input at a future meeting.

The City's Comprehensive Plan was established soon after the City was incorporated, but again, there were very few residents at that time. It's now been 9 years since incorporation, and Westlake now has a growing population of over 3,000 households. It's time to establish a Comprehensive Plan Review and a series of public hearings that will allow for public input for suggested amendments by residents.

Every resident I've talked with <u>does not support</u> a Walmart coming to Westlake. The Mayor and Council must retain the services of an economist/market analyst, experienced in new community land use to help identify the most resident friendly use of commercial property. The Mayor and Council must politely request that <u>Minto decision-maker John Carter</u> appear at a special community Town Hall here, to discuss the proposed Walmart.

Lastly, the City roads and traffic signs will remain under the control of the Seminole Improvement District for 30 years. It's only common sense for the City of Westlake to control the roads and traffic signs. This agreement does not benefit residents and must be changed NOW! I urge the Mayor and Council to schedule a special public hearing as soon as possible to address the issue. If Florida statutes require a referendum vote by citizens on any of these changes, I support this citizen vote wholeheartedly. I have been a frequent visitor to local, county and state meetings and hearings for many years and bring a citizen's point of view to the council! I sincerely ask for the Mayor's nomination and your vote on February 25.
