AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SEC. 9-3005 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF WEST MONROE, LOUISIANA, ADDING THE PROVISION THAT IT IS UNLAWFUL FOR THE OWNER OR OPERATOR OF ANY VEHICLE TO PARK THE VEHICLE OR ALLOW THE VEHICLE TO REMAIN PARKED IN ANY LOCATIONS ON THE STREETS AND ALLEYS OF THE CITY WHICH IS ESTABLISHED, DESIGNATED, OR INDICATED BY WORDS OR SYMBOLS AS AN ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATION EXCEPT FOR THE PURPOSE OF CHARGING AN ELECTRIC VEHICLE (EV) AT THAT LOCATION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND TO OTHERWISE PROVIDE WITH RESPECT THERETO.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of West Monroe, Louisiana, in regular and legal session convened, that Section 9-3005 of the Code of Ordinances, City of West Monroe, Louisiana, is hereby amended, to now read as follows:

“Sec. 9-3005. Special purpose parking zones; electric charging stations

- A. It is unlawful for the owner or operator of any vehicle to park the vehicle or allow the vehicle to remain parked in any locations on the streets and alleys of the city in established and designated special purpose parking zones except as indicated and specified by posted signs.
- B. It is unlawful for the owner or operator of any vehicle to park the vehicle or allow the vehicle to remain parked in any locations on the streets and alleys of the city which is established, designated, or indicated by words or symbols as an electric vehicle charging station except for the purpose of charging an electric vehicle (EV) at that location.”

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of West Monroe, Louisiana, in regular and legal session convened, that this amendment shall be effective March 31, 2023.
