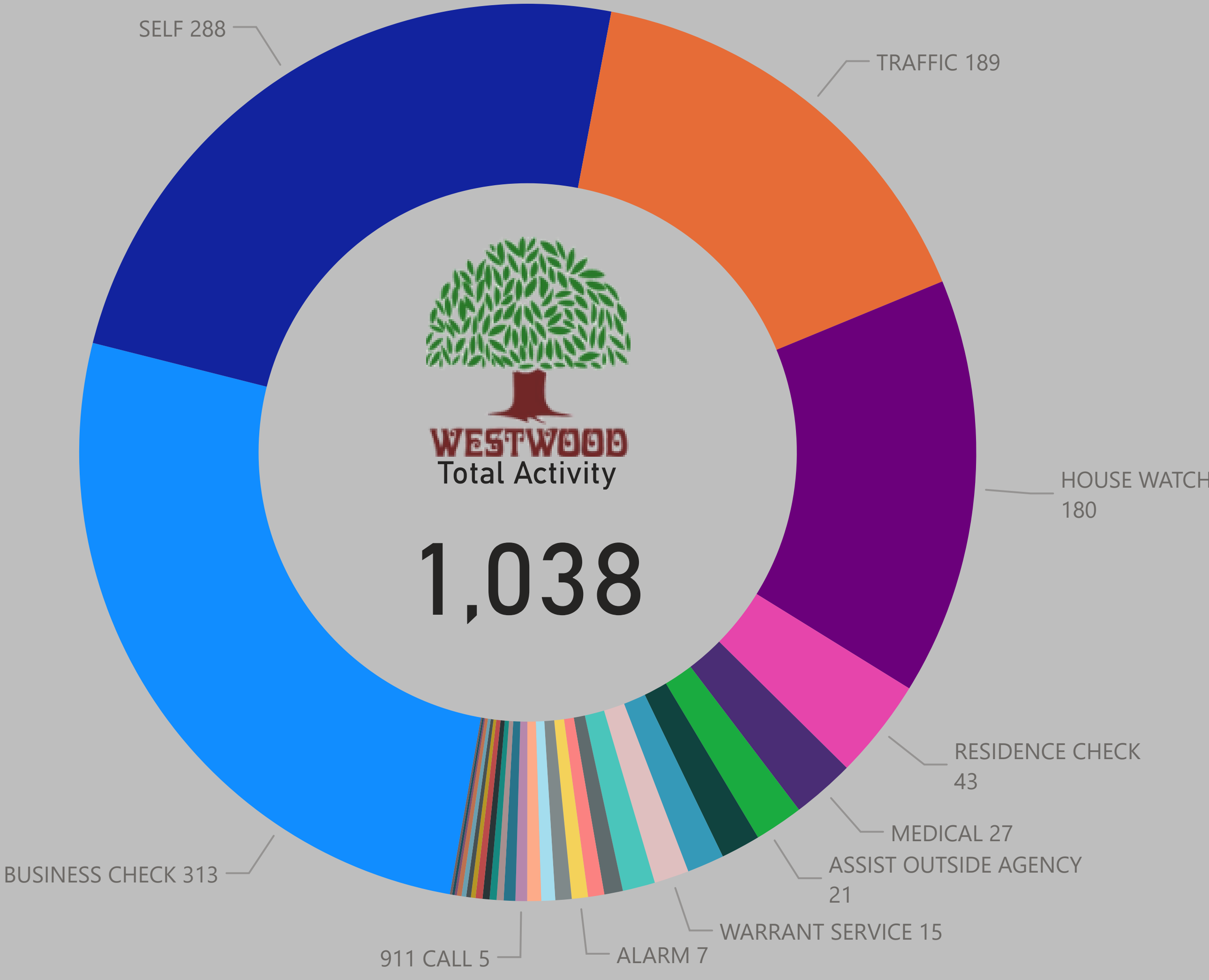

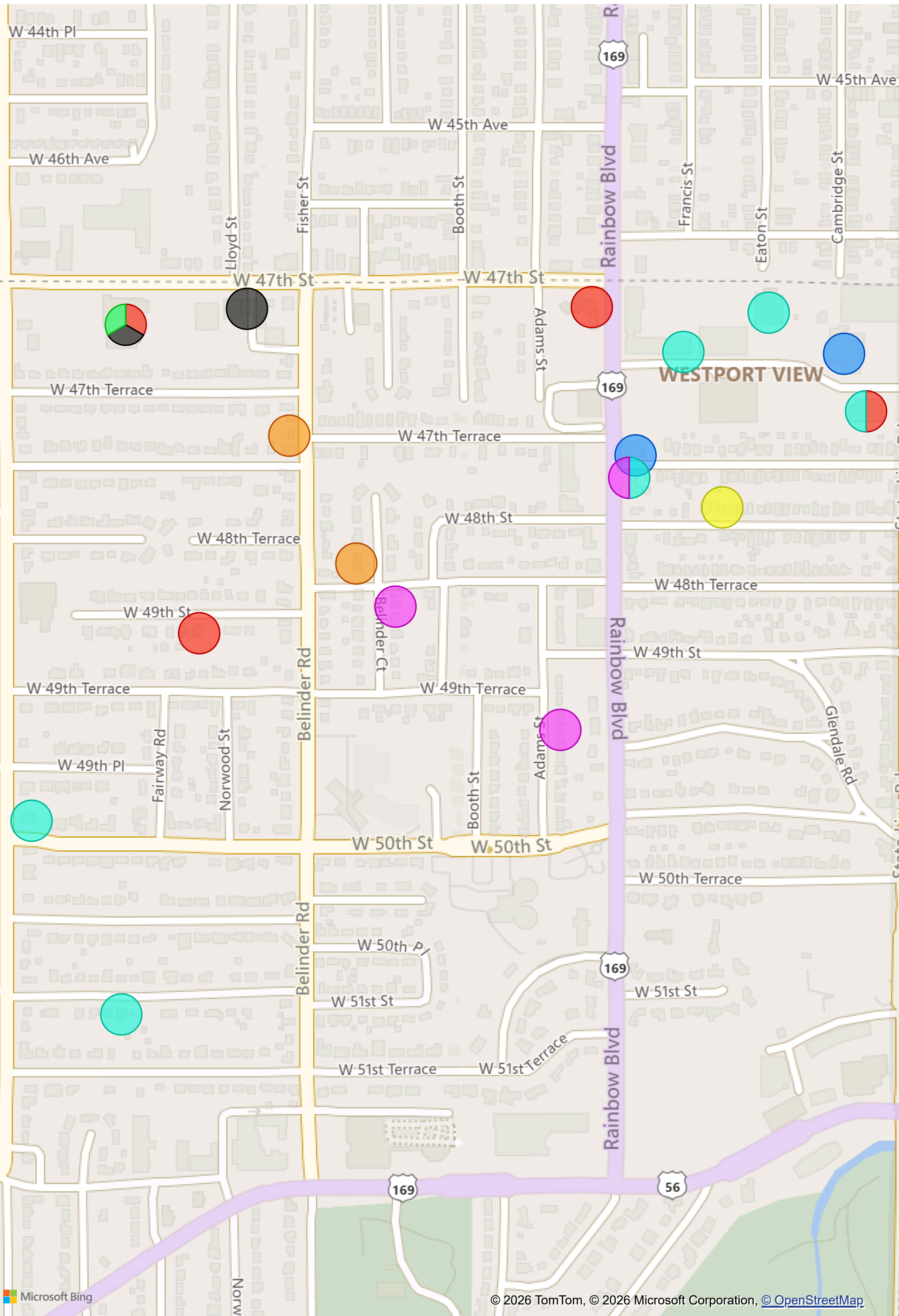

| Case Number | Report Type | Summary |
|-------------|-----------------------------|--|
| 20250430 | Accident-Non Injury | The vehicle was traveling eastbound on W 47th Place going down hill and she slid down on the snow, left the road and struck the monument sign in front of 1901 W 47th Place building. |
| 20250431 | Accident-Non Injury | Vehicle was driving eastbound on W 47th Place and as she started to go down hill, lost control of the vehicle due to the ice on the road and crashed against the curb and broke the tire control arm. The driver was not injured. |
| 20250438 | Criminal Damage to Property | Reporting officer was dispatched to an attempted auto theft. An unknown suspect(s) attempted to turn the ignition with some type of tool. The steering column was already damaged. The unknown suspect(s) damaged the steering column further. The vehicle was not stolen. |
| 20250444 | Drugs/Narcotics | Reporting officer conducted traffic on an individual. Individual obstructed by failing to comply to lawful orders. Found marijuana and paraphernalia. Transported to Olathe ADC. |
| 20250448 | Accident-Non Injury | Vehicle 2 was stopped in the number 1 lane near the south bound 4700 block of Rainbow Blvd. Vehicle 1 was traveling south bound in the number 1 lane near the 4700 block of Rainbow Blvd striking Vehicle 2 from behind. |
| 20250450 | Theft | The reporting party left copper wire in a laundry basket on the side of a house he is remodeling and someone stole the wire and left the basket |
| 20250452 | Accident-Non Injury | The vehicle was parked unoccupied on the south side of the street facing east when its left outside mirror appears to have been stuck by another vehicle as it passed by, which then left the scene. |
| 20250461 | Criminal Trespass | Reporting officer responded to Walmart for an active verbal disturbance between a male subject and staff. The subject was detained, given a written trespass warning, and was released. |
| 20250462 | Theft | The reporting party, a Westwood resident, reported she believes she lost a gun while traveling between locations in the metro area. A courtesy report was taken so that the gun could be entered as missing in the NCIC |

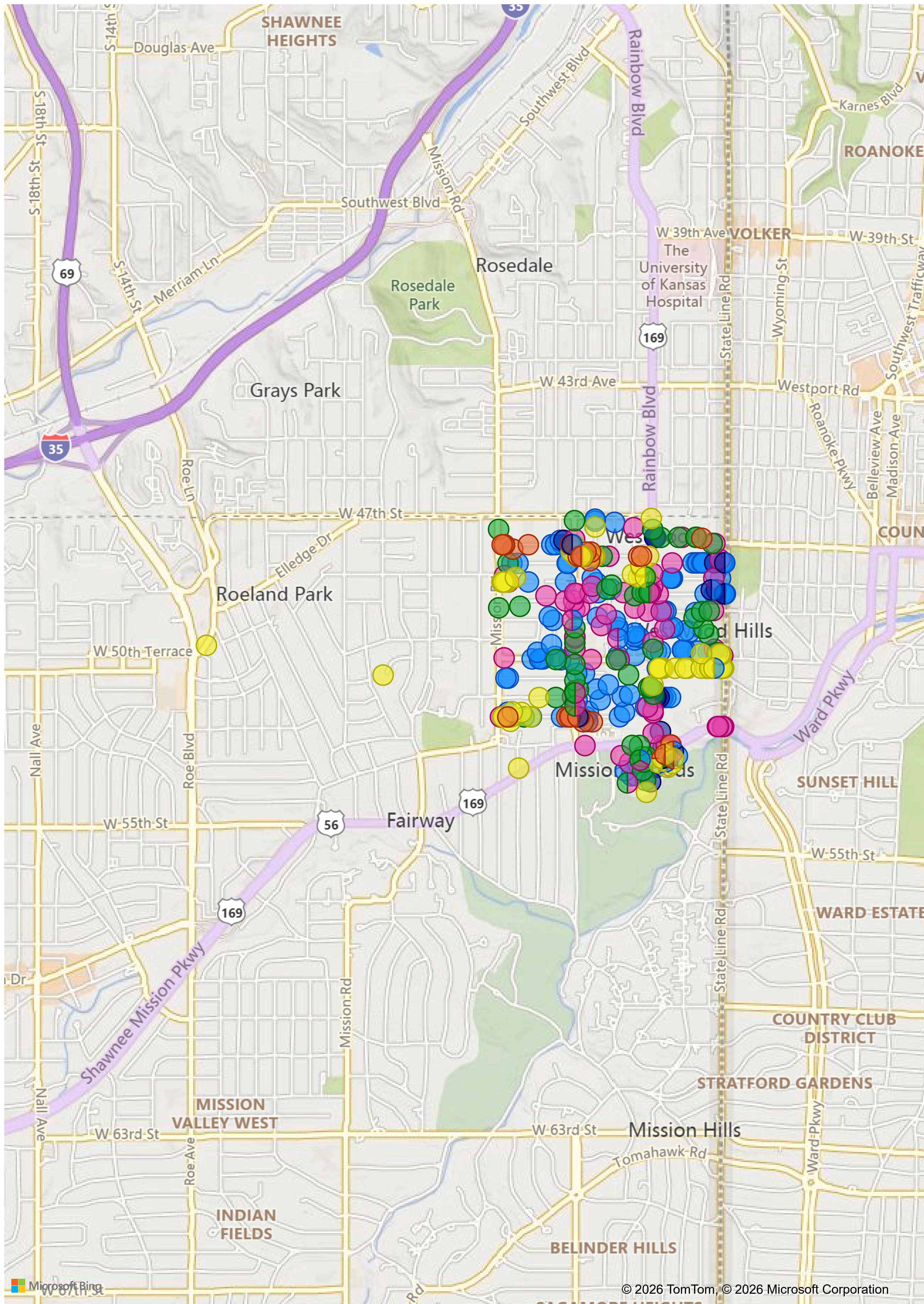
