

**RESOLUTION NO. 26-XX**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHEATLAND  
AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AGREEMENTS BETWEEN OLIVEHURST  
PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT (DISTRICT) AND CITY OF WHEATLAND (CITY)  
REGARDING PROVISION OF REGIONAL WASTEWATER TREATMENT SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the District and the City each currently own, operate, and maintain separate facilities for the collection and treatment of wastewater in their respective service areas; and

WHEREAS, the District owns and operates a Wastewater Treatment Facility ("Facility") located at 3908 Mary Avenue, Olivehurst, California, and which is capable of accepting flows from the City; and

WHEREAS, to safeguard water quality in the region, protect the environment, and promote the health, safety, and general welfare of both the District and the City, the Parties have determined it is in their mutual best interests to develop a framework for a regional approach to wastewater treatment and conveyance in South Yuba County; and

WHEREAS, the City's existing wastewater treatment plant is not sufficient to meet anticipated regulatory requirements or the City's anticipated growth; and

WHEREAS, the Parties are working collaboratively to design, construct and finance a conveyance system capable of delivering 1.5 million gallons per day (MGD) average dry weather flow and 3.3 MGD peak flow from the City's and District's service areas to the Facility; and

WHEREAS, the District warrants the Facility has current and future expansion capacity to receive and treat the City's current and anticipated flow from the conveyance system to be constructed; and

WHEREAS, the City intends to secure capacity in the Facility and reimburse the District for treatment services pursuant to agreements to be drafted between the District and the City; and

WHEREAS, on February 28, 2023, the Wheatland City Council adopted Resolution No. 07-23 establishing the framework of principles underlying the City's participation in the District's wastewater treatment plant; and

WHEREAS, the Wheatland City Council, on July 23, 2024, adopted Resolution No. 37-24 authorizing execution of agreements between Olivehurst Public Utility District and the City of Wheatland regarding provision of regional wastewater treatment services; and

WHEREAS, several amendments have been made to the draft agreements as the project for providing regional wastewater treatment services has become more defined; and

WHEREAS, **Attachments '2' and '3'** to this resolution together constitute in substantial form the Capacity Purchase Agreement and Wastewater Treatment and Operations Agreement, respectively between the City and the District, which agreements were approved by the District's Board of Directors on January 15, 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Wheatland that the City Council hereby approves the Capacity Purchase Agreement and Wastewater Treatment and Operations Agreement in substantially the form set forth in **Attachments '2' and '3'**, and directs staff to prepare final agreements consistent with this resolution.
