Recommendation:

Staff recommends that the Wheatland City Council receive and file this informational staff report regarding the calls received by the City's police and fire services for public safety support related to the Bishop's Pumpkin Farm 2024 season.

Discussion:

The Bishop's Pumpkin Farm was open for the 2024 season from Saturday, September 7th to Monday, November 11th (approximately 9 weeks). City staff is developing a detailed report on the traffic management plan, public safety support and revenue generated by the City during the Bishop's Pumpkin Farm 2024 season. City staff expect to present the report to the City Council in early 2025.

At the November 12, 2024 City Council meeting, the City Council requested that information on the calls for police and fire services related to the Bishop's Pumpkin Farm 2024 season be presented at the December 10th City Council meeting. The Council also requested comparative information for the past several years. That information is provided in the table below.
