**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF WHEATLAND ADOPTING THE OLIVEHURST PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT'S
INITIAL STUDY/MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION AND MITIGATION
MONITORING AND REPORTING PROGRAM AS THE CEQA RESPONSIBLE
AGENCY AS ADEQUATE FOR THE DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS FROM THE STATE
WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD CLEAN WATER STATE REVOLVING
FUND PURSUANT TO THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT.**

WHEREAS, the Olivehurst Public Utility District (OPUD) prepared an Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) and Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program (MMRP) to evaluate the potential environmental impacts of the South Yuba County Water and Wastewater Infrastructure Improvement Project (the "Project") in conformance with Section 15063 of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations (the "CEQA Guidelines"); and

WHEREAS, the City of Wheatland has been determined to be a Responsible Agency and is required to adopt the IS/MND and MMRP; and

WHEREAS, the IS/MND concluded that the Project, with the implementation of the mitigation measures recommended in the IS/MND, will not have a significant effect on the environment. The Final IS/MND and MMRP are attached as Exhibit A and Exhibit B to this Resolution respectively.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND DETERMINED, that the Wheatland City Council does determine as follows:

- A. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
- B. The IS/MND and MMRP have been completed in compliance with CEQA and the CEQA Guidelines.
- C. The IS/MND and MMRP were presented to the City Council who reviewed and considered the information contained therein prior to adoption. The IS/MND and MMRP reflect the City Council's independent judgment and analysis as to the environmental effects of the Project.
- D. The City Council hereby adopts the IS/MND and MMRP as adequate..
- E. The City Council hereby adopts the mitigation measures as set forth in the IS/MND and MMRP, which are attached hereto as Exhibit A and B, respectively, and incorporated herein by reference. The City will use the MMRP to track compliance with the Project's mitigation measures as applicable to the grant requirements. The MMRP will remain available for public review during the compliance period.
