

**RESOLUTION NO. 55-25**

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHEATLAND ACCEPTING A REPORT ON MULTI-WAY STOP CONTROLS AT THE WHEATLAND ROAD AND OAKLEY LANE INTERSECTION, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO MODIFY THE INTERSECTION TO A 4-WAY STOP CONTROLLED INTERSECTION.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Wheatland has received complaints from motorists and citizens about the safety of the intersection of Wheatland Road and Oakley Lane; and

**WHEREAS**, on November 17, 2025, the City Engineer completed a report entitled, *Multi-Way Stop Sign Warrant Study at Wheatland Road and Oakley Lane, Wheatland, CA* ("Study"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Study concludes that the conversion of the intersection from a 2-way stop controlled intersection to a 4-way stop controlled intersection is warranted and recommended to improve safety at the intersection, and that the 4-way stop installation should be constructed in accordance with the latest version of the California Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (CAMUTCD) and industry practices as directed by the City Engineer.

**NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, ORDERED AND FOUND** by the City Council of the City of Wheatland, State of California, that the City Council received the report from the City Engineer entitled *Multi-Way Stop Sign Warrant Study at Wheatland Road and Oakley Lane, Wheatland, CA*, dated November 17, 2025, and authorizes and directs the City Manager and City Staff to install 4-way stop controls at the intersection of Wheatland Road and Oakley Lane utilizing the Street Maintenance Gas Tax Fund (Fund #102000).
