SUBJECT: Stanley Park Phase II Grant Application

A Township Board resolution in support of the Stanley Park Phase II Land and Water Conservation Fund (LWCF) grant application is required by the State. The resolution was prepared using the State's LWCF application guidebook. Beckett & Raeder reviewed the resolution and confirmed it meets the requirements of the State. The resolution reflects a \$1 million project price, with a 50% match from the Township (\$500,000).

The March 18 public hearing on this topic is required by the State to allow residents the opportunity to provide feedback on the grant application and development of the property as a Township park. After action by the Board on March 18, staff and Beckett & Raeder will finalize work on the grant application and submit it to the State by the April 1 deadline.
