TO: Township Board FROM: Rik Kowall DATE: June 18, 2025 RE: Liquor License Request (Parks and Recreation Committee)

The Parks and Recreation Committee is requesting Township Board approval to apply for a one-day liquor license to sell beer and wine at an event scheduled for Friday, July 18, 2025, at Fisk Farm. The license type is a "Special License for Consumption on the Premises," which is issued by the Michigan Liquor Control Commission (MLCC) under the authority of the Michigan Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs (LARA). A certified copy of a resolution by the Township Board authorizing the license request must be included in the application to the State.

For municipalities, the fee for the "Special License" is \$50. The license is valid for one day, with sales restricted from 7:00 a.m. until 2:00 a.m. The event will run from approximately 6:00 p.m. until 9:00 p.m. The Parks and Recreation Committee is prepared to provide a secure site with appropriate barriers as required by law and monitor and restrict beer/wine sales from visibly intoxicated persons and minors.

The following motion is provided for the Board's consideration:

Move to approve resolution #25-016 special liquor license application for a one-day liquor license from the Michigan Liquor Control Commission for the sale of beer and wine at an event on July 18, 2025, authorizing the Supervisor and required staff to sign the necessary documents for the application.

Under administrative rule R 436.1003, the licensee shall comply with all state and local building, plumbing, zoning, sanitation, and health laws, rules, and ordinances as determined by the state and local law enforcements officials who have jurisdiction over the licensee. Approval of this application by the Michigan Liquor Control Commission does not waive any of these requirements. The licensee must obtain all other required state and local licenses, permits, and approvals for this business before using this license for the sale of alcoholic liquor on the licensed premises.

We certify that the information contained in this form is true and accurate to the best of our knowledge and belief. We agree to comply with all requirements of the Michigan Liquor Control Code and Administrative Rules. We also understand that providing **false** or **fraudulent** information is a violation of the Liquor Control Code pursuant to MCL 436.2003.
