

Equipment & Technology:

We received a \$2500 grant from Bridges to purchase Makerspace equipment. We now have an
embroidery machine, an upgraded scanner (much needed!), a sublimation printer, a heat press,
and printmaking supplies. We will also be purchasing 3 tabletop printing presses, but they are
currently backordered. I am working on setting up this new equipment, creating instructions,
and testing it before I begin offering patron training.

• I trained Rachel on how to train people on the Makerspace equipment so she can help fill in for me during my leave.

• I am creating video tutorials for the Makerspace equipment. This will be quite a long project.

Eventually, all of the tutorials will be available on our website and YouTube page.

I loaded the translation software onto an iPad for staff to use at the front desk.

Donations: Ribbon, baskets, paper, button maker and a big box of button-making supplies from patrons.

Other Updates:

• I attended the first-annual S.T.E.A.M. Faire at the Whitewater H.S. It was well attended and I talked to 74 people. I promoted the Summer Reading Program, the Makerspace, and the STEAM

kits we have for checkout. I provided a DIY Paper Toy and Makey Makey activities.

• Sent out the June newsletter and created the paper calendar. The newsletter was sent to 3,210

people and had 1,173

• Deana and I hosted a group of about 60 2nd graders from Lincoln Elementary. We promoted the

Summer Reading Program, read a story, and gave them a tour of the library and goodie bags.

• I installed the small display case for the adult Summer Reading Program. Deana and I installed

the large display case for the children's Summer Reading Program.

I received a thank you note from a patron who has been enjoying our adult programming. She

especially loved the Judy Garland and Guided Journaling programs.
