

Twin Oaks Severe Weather Evacuation Plan

Introduction:

In the event severe weather should strike the area, or when you hear the audible Severe Weather Siren/Tornado, you are encouraged to proceed to the Storm Shelter at The Garages/Mailboxes. The Storm Shelter will provide safe refuge for each resident of Twin Oaks. DO NOT remain in your home.

****Purpose: To ensure safety and preparedness for residents and pets during storms.***

**** Scope: Covers preparations, emergency response and recovery for all storms***

3. Mobile Home Community Storm Plan

- ***Check mobile home tie-downs, roofs,***
- ***Storm kits- Flashlights, batteries, first aid, food,***
- ***Resident education – Annual meetings on storm plan, Flyers and brochures***
- ***Evacuation plan – Routes, pet-friendly shelters, transportation for those without a vehicle, pet evacuation plan and supplies.***

5. Emergency Procedures

**** During storm- Stay indoors, avoid windows***

** Use community shelters or safe zones, Check-in protocol with management,*

6. Utility management-

** Instructions for turning off utilities*

** Coordination with utility companies*

7. Special Considerations

- *Vulnerable residents- special assistance plan for elderly and disabled, contact list for those needing help*
- *Children- coordination with schools*

8. Pets

- *During evacuation- Owners must transport pets in a Kennel, Pet Taxi or other approved Pet Transportation Cage and bring them to the garage, pets must be kenneled at all times during these events.*
- *Preparation- Ensure pets have ID tags and microchips, pet emergency kits (food, water, medications)*
- *Post-storm- check pets for injury, comfort pets and keep them secure*

9. Access to the Storm Shelter: *Should severe weather strike our area, the Property Manager; or a Volunteer (755 N Tratt St Lot#18) will unlock the Storm Shelter. Call 911 and the Whitewater Police Department or Whitewater Fire Department will unlock the Storm Shelter.*
