

7.72.041 - Bow hunting.

Hunting with a bow or crossbow is permitted on privately owned land. No bow hunting is allowed within one hundred yards of any building located on another person's land (unless permission is granted by the other person). In this section "building" means a permanent structure used for human occupancy and includes a manufactured home, as defined by Wisconsin Statutes 101.91(2). A bow or crossbow must be discharged toward the ground.

7.72.045 - Prohibited hunting on city owned land.

Hunting is prohibited on all City of Whitewater owned land, unless the hunting is allowed under an established hunting program authorized and approved by the city council.

7.72.050 - Penalty for violations.

Any person who violates any of the provisions of this chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to a penalty of not less than \$400.00 or more than \$750.00 for the first offense, and for second and subsequent offenses not less than \$450.00 or more than \$750.00, together with the costs of prosecution; and in default of payment of such forfeiture and costs of prosecution, shall be imprisoned in the county jail until such forfeiture and costs are paid, but not exceeding thirty days.
