

BACKGROUND

The City has a Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) Permit from the DNR. As part of the permit, the City is required to remove Totals Suspended Solids and Total Phosphorus from stormwater runoff. To keep the DNR apprised of our doings, the City has a Stormwater Quality Management Plan (SQMP), which was last updated in 2017. The SQMP updates where the City stands in compliance with Total Suspended Solids and Total Phosphorus removal in meeting the Rock River total maximum daily load (TMDL) criteria. The SQMP also provides alternative analysis and an implementation plan on how the City plans on meeting the TMDL criteria in the future.

PREVIOUS ACTIONS - COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS

The Common Council approved Task Order 24-02 in January 2024 to update the SQMP. The Public Works Committee approved the SQMP at their October 14, 2025 meeting.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The SQMP involves a number of projects within the recommended Implementation Plan to meet the TDML removal requirements. Projects will be selected and submitted for Capital Improvement Projects in future years. Money to pay for these projects will come from the Stormwater Utility.
