

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPROVAL OF THE BARGAINING AGREEMENT WITH THE WHITEWATER PROFESSIONAL POLICE ASSOCIATION

WHEREAS, this resolution was reviewed by the Union Ratification and is recommended for approval by said committee; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Whitewater has engaged in collective bargaining with the Wisconsin Profession Police Association (WPPA) and the Whitewater Police Union regarding wages, hours, and working conditions; and,

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Professional Police Association (WPPA) Union membership has ratified the terms of the collective bargaining agreement through a vote in favor of approval; and,

WHEREAS, the negotiated agreement reflects terms that are fair, fiscally responsible, and in the best interest of both the City and its police employees; and,

WHEREAS, the agreement supports the City’s ability to recruit and retain qualified law enforcement personnel while maintaining effective public safety services;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the **Common Council of the City of Whitewater, Walworth and Jefferson Counties, Wisconsin**, that the City of Whitewater hereby authorizes the City Manager and appropriate City officials to execute and implement the collective bargaining agreement between the City of Whitewater and the Whitewater Police Union (WPPA) for a two (2) year term.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Finance Department is authorized to allocate funds consistent with the terms of the agreement as adopted in the City budget.
