### BACKGROUND

Following a review of the municipal code, staff identified an absence of permit expiration timeframes, other than those related to state statute for new construction and commercial projects. Accordingly, we request the creation and adoption of a permit expiration ordinance. Permit expirations for projects involving fencing, siding, decking, and accessory structures would no longer remain active for a two-year period, thereby preventing such projects from remaining incomplete for extended durations. Additionally, reducing the permit expiration period for commercial additions and alterations valued under \$500,000 from two years to one year will help ensure timely completion and discourage projects from lingering in a partially completed state.
