

**INITIAL RESOLUTION TO DISCONTINUE PUBLIC  
WAY OF PLATTED UNNAMED ALLEY WEST OF N.  
JEFFERSON STREET, NORTH OF E. MAIN  
STREET, AND SOUTH OF E. NORTH STREET**

**WHEREAS**, it is proposed that the public interest requires that a portion of the unnamed alley bounded by N. Jefferson Street, E. Main Street, E. North Street and the Whitewater Creek, that has not previously been vacated, be vacated and discontinued; and

**WHEREAS**, the Public Works Committee of the City of Whitewater met on April 14, 2026 and voted in favor to move forward to vacate and discontinue said alley; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the purpose of this Resolution to state the intent of the City Council to vacate and discontinue that portion of the unnamed alley generally described above and particularly described below; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Common Council of the City of Whitewater, Wisconsin:

Section 1. That the Common Council of the City of Whitewater, Wisconsin, hereby proposes to determine whether the public interest requires that a portion of the unnamed alley in City of Whitewater, Walworth County, Wisconsin, as hereinafter described, is to be vacated and discontinued pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 66.1003.

**LEGAL DESCRIPTION**

That part of the unnamed alley west of Jefferson Street, north of E. Main Street, south of E. North Street and east of Whitewater Creek as platted in WM. BIRGES ADDITION to the City of Whitewater.

Section 2. That the City Clerk of the City of Whitewater be authorized and directed to give notice required by Wis. Stat. § 66.1003; and

Section 3. That according to Wis. Stat. § 66.1005, upon vacation and discontinuance of said portion of the unnamed alley, title to the above-described land shall belong to the adjoining property owners, all of which is the City of Whitewater and shall acquire an ownership interest in the entire area being vacated as shown on the attached Exhibit “A”; and;

Section 4. That this Resolution be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.

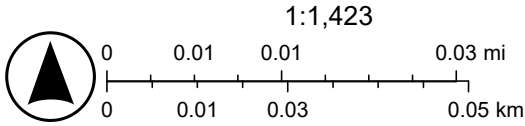
