RESOLUTION 2026-006**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITTIER, ALASKA,
SETTING THE MILL LEVY AT 8.00 MILLS, SETTING THE DATE OF THE BOARD
OF EQUALIZATION HEARING, AND ESTABLISHING THE DATE ON WHICH
PROPERTY TAXES BECOME DELINQUENT FOR THE 2026 TAX ROLL**

WHEREAS, AS 29.45.240(a) requires municipalities to fix the rate of levy, date of board of equalization hearing, and delinquency date by resolution;

WHEREAS, Whittier Municipal Code 3.12.030 allows the City Council to levy a general tax, not exceeding eight-tenths of one percent of assessed property value, and enforce collection methods; and

WHEREAS, AS 29.45.180(a) requires assessment recipients to notify the assessor of property assessment errors or omissions; and

WHEREAS, AS 29.45.180(b) mandates the assessor mail notices for corrected errors in the assessment roll, allowing a 30-day appeal period.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE WHITTIER CITY COUNCIL HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. The City of Whittier's property tax is hereby levied at a rate of 8.0 mills on all taxable property within the City, collected in accordance with AS 29.45 and WMC 3.12.

Section 2. The Board of Equalization convenes on Tuesday May 19, 2026, at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers, 3rd Floor, Public Safety Building, 660 Whittier Street.

Section 3. Property taxes are delinquent if unpaid by 5:00 p.m. on Monday, November 2, 2026, since the standard due date of October 31 falls on a non-business day.

Section 4. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
