**A RESOLUTION CANVASSING AND/OR ACCEPTING APRIL 8, 2025 ELECTION RESULTS**

**WHEREAS**, the general election for the City of Willard was duly and legally held on April 8, 2025, as provided by law; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Aldermen of the City of Willard met on this 28<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2025, a quorum being present, at 6 o'clock p.m., and has canvassed the returns, and has determined the number of votes received by each candidate, as reported by the Clerk of Greene County, Missouri; and

**WHEREAS**, the said municipal governing body accepts and sets forth the result of said election;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF WILLARD, GREENE COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That Troy Smith received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Mayor and is hereby declared duly elected to that office for the term beginning on the 4<sup>th</sup> Monday in April, 2025.
2. That Jeremy Hill received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Alderman—Ward 1 and is hereby declared duly elected to that office for the term beginning on the 4<sup>th</sup> Monday in April, 2025.
3. That David Keene received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Alderman—Ward 2 and is hereby declared duly elected to that office for the term beginning on the 4<sup>th</sup> Monday in April, 2025.
4. That Rachel Mathison received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Alderman—Ward 3 and is hereby declared duly elected to that office for the term beginning on the 4<sup>th</sup> Monday in April, 2025.
