AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF WILLARD, MISSOURI, ACCEPTING A BID FROM GFL ENVIRONMENTAL, INC. FOR RECYCLING COLLECTION SERVICES AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE RELATED AGREEMENTS

WHEREAS, the City of Willard, Missouri ("City"), has a need for reliable and economical recycling collection and removal services; and

WHEREAS, the City, in accordance with applicable laws and regulations, including Revised Missouri Statutes Section 34.040, issued a Request for Proposals seeking competitive bids from qualified vendors to provide recycling collection services; and

WHEREAS, sealed bids were received and publicly opened in accordance with said requirements; and

WHEREAS, after careful review and evaluation of the proposals received, the City determined that the bid submitted by GFL Environmental, Inc. ("GFL") is the most responsive and responsible and represents the best value and service to the City for recycling collection services; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into a service agreement with GFL for recycling collection services under the terms and conditions set forth in the proposal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF WILLARD, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The bid submitted by GFL Environmental, Inc. for recycling collection services, as outlined in the proposal and specifications, is hereby accepted.

SECTION II: The Board of Aldermen hereby approves the service agreement with GFL Environmental, Inc., in substantial conformity with the terms and conditions set forth in Exhibit 1, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as if fully set out. The Mayor, City Administrator, and other appropriate City officials are hereby authorized and directed to execute the agreement and any related documents, and to take all actions necessary, desirable, convenient, or appropriate to carry out the intent and purpose of this ordinance.

SECTION III: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
