

Planning and Development Quarterly Summary 2025

This year has been marked by steady progress and meaningful development across infrastructure, planning, and community services.

Currently 133 permits pulled for the current year-\$87,000.00 in permit fees

The LDS church was approved for construction and is underway. This will add over 2500 feet of 10" waterline West of hwy 160 on Farm Road 76.

McDonalds on Hunt Road has been approved and is underway.

A commercial building (6000 sq ft) on Daniel Lane has been approved and is underway.

Willard Heights rezoned and plat revised- moving forward with a remodel of the existing buildings

Finalized design of the underpass at AB and Highway 160, a key project aimed at improving pedestrian flow and safety of citizens, particularly school children attending Willard North..

Significant investments were made in education facilities, with remodels and upgrades completed at Willard North, Willard Middle, and Willard East Schools, enhancing learning environments for students and staff; these have been finalized and are currently in use.

Addressing parking downtown with 10 new spots across from Darla's Diner

Looking forward to our plan of revising and updating our comprehensive plan in 2027. We will be putting an RFQ out in the fourth quarter of 2026 to advertise for this event. We look forward to public engagement and comment on this important topic.
