## **RESOLUTION NO. 2025-18**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF WILLOWICK TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT ANY AND ALL APPLICATIONS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE COMPETITIVE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025, AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED FOR THE PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Whereas, the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program is a flexible program that provides communities with resources to address a wide range of unique community development needs; and

Whereas, the Lake County Commissioners, as funding permits, allocates CDBG funds pursuant to an application process from communities within Lake County; and

Whereas, the Council agrees that it is in the best interests of the City and its residents to authorize the Mayor to make application to the Lake Cunty Commissioners and request CBDG funds to the following proposed projects: ADA improvements at the Fire Station and improved street signage.

**Now therefore, be it resolved** by the City Council of the City of Willowick, Ohio, as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> The City of Willowick hereby authorizes the Mayor to make any applications necessary to the Lake County Commissioners to request fuds from the CDBG program for the following proposed projects: ADA improvements at the Fire Station and improved street signage.

<u>Section 2</u>. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were conducted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such actions were conducted in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 123 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willowick.

<u>Section 3.</u> This Resolution constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willowick and further provides for the usual and necessary daily operation of the Lakefront Park; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
